GAME 1

DETROIT (AP) — The Lions capitalized on 14 Packers penalties and three turnovers, and Joey Harrington threw two touchdown passes, including one to rookie Mike Williams with 4:13 left, in a season-opening win at Ford Field.

The game marked the fewest points Green Bay scored with Brett Favre as its starting quarterback. Tampa Bay beat the Packers 31-3 on Sept. 13, 1992, two weeks before Favre began his record streak of starting 226 consecutive games, including the playoffs. The Packers were shut out of the end zone for the first time since Sept. 17, 2000, ending a franchise-record 77-game streak, the longest in the NFL at the time.

Favre fumbled on the opening possession of the second half, leading to Jason Hanson's 21-yard field goal. His interception midway through the fourth quarter, snagged by a diving Kenoy Kennedy, whose fumble was caught by teammate Holt, led to Williams' 3-yard TD catch. Then Green Bay drove to Detroit's 12 before Favre was sacked twice and suffered his second interception.

Among Green Bay's 14 penalties (its most since Nov. 1, 1987), four offensive flags wiped out 75 yards in gains, including a 55-yard play in which Javon Walker was called for pass interference, two third-down defensive flags kept crucial Lions drives alive, and one special-teams whistle erased a 47-yard Antonio Chatman punt return. Ahman Green was held to 58 yards rushing, but penalties wiped out 32. Cornerback Ahmad Carroll was flagged for illegal use of hands three times, including twice on one drive.

In a game expected to be high-scoring, both teams struggled offensively. Green Bay's offense took a hit when Walker, Favre's favorite target, injured his right knee in the third quarter on the 55-yard catch in which he was penalized. An MRI the next day confirmed a torn anterior cruciate ligament, ending Walker's season before it really had a chance to start.

Green Bay got to the Lions' 4 on the ensuing drive, but holder B.J. Sander mishandled a good snap on an aborted field-goal attempt.

On the Packers' next possession, Ryan Longwell kicked a 50-yard field goal (his 10th career of 50-plus).

GREEN BAY (AP) — Trent Dilfer won for the first time in nine trips to Lambeau Field, guiding Cleveland over the mistake-prone Packers 26-24 for new coach Romeo Crennel's first win. Dilfer threw an 80-yard touchdown pass to Braylon Edwards and a game-icing 62-yarder to Steve Heiden with 1:50 remaining.

Dilfer, who lost six times as a starter at Green Bay, completed 21 of 32 passes for 336 yards — the second-highest total of his career — and three touchdowns. His 62-yarder to Heiden, who slipped a tackle by safety Mark Roman, made it 26-17, too much for the Packers to overcome even behind Brett Favre. After retiring his number in a moving halftime ceremony, the Packers wanted desperately to honor Reggie White with a win. So did Dilfer, who like so many others, counted himself a friend of the "Minister of Defense," who died unexpectedly last year at age 43.

"I guarantee you, he and my son were watching the game together today," said Dilfer, who lost his 5-year-old son, Trevin, to a rare infection in 2003.

Favre broke John Elway's single-stadium NFL touchdown record of 180 with a 4-yard toss to Tony Fisher with 4 seconds left, but Brodney Pool recovered the onside kick for Cleveland (1-1).

The Browns were backed up and facing a crucial third down after Favre, who also joined Dan Marino and Elway in the 50,000-yard passing club, pulled the Packers to 19-17 with a 19-yard TD to Robert Ferguson with 3:40 remaining.

With the crowd chanting "Reg-gie! Reg-gie!" in honor of the late White, whose number was retired at halftime, Dilfer calmly hit running back Reuben Droughns for a 12-yard gain on third-and-5. Then, following the 2-minute warning, he found Heiden over the middle to put the game out of reach. The Packers (0-2) looked at first like they wouldn't miss Jason Walker, their star receiver who went down with a season-ending knee injury the previous week. They went ahead 7-0 on their first possession when Donald Driver caught a short pass over the middle and raced past Ray Mickens and Chris Crocker for a 42-yard score. But the Browns answered with their own TD drive and Phil Dawson added field goals of 21 and 39 yards to give the Browns a 13-7 halftime lead. His first field goal followed the first of Favre's two interceptions.

The Packers came out of the locker room early to watch White's No. 92 unveiled beneath the north end zone alongside those of Don Hutson, Tony Canadeo, Bart Starr and Ray Nitschke. White's widow, Sara, spoke to the crowd, and highlights were shown of White sacking quarterback after quarterback and holding the Lombardi Trophy aloft after the Packers' Super Bowl win following the 1996 season.

Jecolia White, White's 17-year-old daughter, sang the national anthem. ... Favre's 20-yard run was his longest since 1999.

GREEN BAY (AP) — Carnell "Cadillac" Williams helped the Buccaneers snap a 13-game road losing streak to Green Bay with a 17-16 win. He broke Alan Ameche's NFL record for most yards in his first three NFL games by rushing for 158. The Buccaneers (3-0) also got two touchdown receptions from Joey Galloway and two interceptions from safety Will Allen in winning at Lambeau Field for the first time since Sept 10, 1989.

Ryan Longwell missed an extra point for the first time in 157 attempts, and that was the difference as the Packers fell to 0-3 for the first time since Brett Favre was a sophomore at Southern Miss in 1988.

The most important of Williams' 37 carries came after Allen, subbing for an injured Dexter Jackson (hamstring), picked off Favre for the second time with 5 minutes remaining. He grabbed the ball and returned it to the 31 after Juran Bolden tipped it away from receiver Robert Ferguson at the Tampa Bay 5-yard line. The Buccaneers ran out the clock when Williams rushed six times for 46 yards.

Long-snapper Rob Davis took the blame for the mixed extra point because of his off-target snap, but Favre pointed the finger squarely at himself. "Yeah, if we make that extra point maybe we go into overtime," Favre said. "But if I make that last throw? I mean that's what Brett Favre is all about. I feel I can be the difference-maker in good times and in bad. I feel like I let this team down."

Trailing 17-13 late in the third quarter, the Packers should have gotten the ball on a fumble by Brian Griese at the Tampa Bay 14, but the whistle blew and Tampa Bay maintained possession on the officiating miscue. Then, the Packers were going in for the go-ahead touchdown when Shelton Quarles got his hand on a pass to Ferguson near the goal line on third down. Green Bay had to settle for Longwell's 32-yard field goal with 7:18 remaining that made it 17-16. Finally, they got the ball at the 50 with just under 6 minutes left, but three plays later, Allen had his second interception, and Williams went to work icing the win.

The Buccaneers led 17-13 at halftime behind touchdown passes of 5 and 10 yards by Galloway, the first of which followed a fumble by Packers fullback William Henderson on Green Bay's opening drive.

The Packers answered with a 37-yard touchdown from Favre to Ferguson on fourth-and-5. But Davis' snap was high and Longwell missed the extra point, leaving the Packers down 7-6. It was his first miss of an extra point after 156 straight conversions, a team record and the fourth-longest active streak in the NFL. Longwell, who also missed a 42-yard field goal in the third quarter, did set a franchise record with a field goal in his 15th straight game. TE Bubba Franks (knee) missed the first game of his six-year career, snapping a streak of 88 straight games played.

CHARLOTTE (AP) — Brett Favre stood alone at midfield, watching in frustrated disbelief as the Carolina Panthers celebrated the end of his improbable rally. It was vintage Favre, but despite his best efforts, the Green Bay Packers fell to their worst start in 17 years.

Favre threw four touchdown passes but couldn't overcome two early turnovers that the Panthers used to build a big lead, and Carolina held on for a 32-29 victory. "It's hard to express in words how disappointed I am. I left it all on the field," Favre said. "I've never been 0-4, but it's a hard we've been dealt."

Rallying Green Bay from a 19-point second-half deficit, Favre threw two TD passes and two 2-point conversions in the fourth quarter and had the Packers in position to win the game on their final drive. But with running back Ahman Green (knee) sidelined and no timeouts, Favre had to do it all on his own when Green Bay got the ball back with 1:58 to play. He completed two passes before Carolina (2-2) stopped the Packers on fourth-and-2. Favre threw the ball to Donald Driver past the first-down marker, but Chris Gamble knocked the ball out of his hands and it fell incomplete. One by one, the Panthers approached Favre in a show of respect. Among them was Mike Wahle, the left guard who spent seven seasons protecting Favre before signing with Carolina. The two embraced.

Jake Delhomme was 17-for-24 for 206 yards and Steve Smith, who scored three touchdowns the previous week at Miami, caught only two passes for 12 yards.

Trailing 26-7 midway through the third quarter, Favre turned it up a level, and suddenly looked again like he was having fun doing it. He led by example on an 80-yard scoring drive, sprinting up the middle for a 12-yard gain on third-and-8 and finishing it off with a 26-yard TD pass to Driver. Favre finished 28-of-47 for 303 yards and four touchdowns — his 19th game of four or more TD passes, second to Dan Marino's record 21. The pass to Driver was Favre's 50th touchdown pass on Monday Night Football, second only to Marino's 74, and it cut Carolina's lead to 26-13. Later, after a Packers punt, Kaber Gbaja-Biamila forced a Delhomme fumble, Green Bay recovered and Favre made the Panthers pay for it one play later with a 16-yard scoring strike to Donald Lee.

His finest work, though, came on the Packers' next drive. Favre was 8-for-12 on a 90-yard march, hitting Antonio Chatman on a 4-yard touchdown in the back of the end zone. Favre threw the 2-point conversion to Robert Ferguson to make it 32-29 with 3:07 to play.

The Packers became only the fifth team in the history of the league to open 0-4 with three of those losses by a field goal or less.

GREEN BAY (AP) — Brett Favre threw three touchdown passes despite playing without four offensive starters and losing running back Najeh Davenport to a season-ending ankle injury in the second quarter of Green Bay's 52-3 win over the New Orleans Saints. After going three-and-out and giving up a field goal, Green Bay (1-4) scored 52 unanswered points.

"When you have a lot of pent-up frustration, you can kind of explode like that," kicker Ryan Longwell said after Green Bay's most lopsided win since Oct. 23, 1966, when it routed Atlanta 56-3.

Davenport scored twice before breaking his right ankle just before halftime, and cornerback Al Harris intercepted two passes, broke up three more and recorded a sack as the Packers piled up their most points since scoring 55 against Tampa Bay in 1983.

The Saints (2-3) couldn't stop a depleted Packers offense that was missing Pro Bowlers Javon Walker, Ahman Green and Bubba Franks (for all but one snap), and starting center Mike Flanagan and also had both tackles playing on gimpy left legs. With the offense clicking, Green Bay's defense kept pace with five takeaways.

"That's the first time I've ever played in a game where we scored 50 points," Favre said. "Who would have guessed it? We're 0-4, struggling, more guys hurt and even lose guys during the course of the game. But I've played long enough to know that if you do things the right way, if you study, prepare and believe, things will go your way."

Favre completed 19 of 27 passes for 215 yards and no interceptions before giving way to rookie Aaron Rodgers to start the fourth quarter.

Green Bay's defense, ranked last in the NFL in turnover differential at minus-9, recovered two fumbles and picked off three passes, including one thrown by backup Todd Bouman that was returned 95 yards for a touchdown by linebacker Nick Barnett with 8:19 remaining. Barnett raced down the Saints' dejected sideline for his first career score and the second-longest interception TD return in franchise history.

Bouman replaced Aaron Brooks, who went to the bench midway through the third quarter after completing 9 of 22 passes for 146 yards and no TDs. Davenport, who made his second career start with Green (knee/quadripleg) deactivated, hopped in from 1 yard to give Green Bay a 7-3 with 2:24 left in the first quarter for the Packers' first touchdown run of the season.

The Packers, who had just two takeaways in the first month, made it 14-3 when Harris jumped in front of Donté Stallworth and returned the interception 22 yards for his third career TD. On the next series, Harris wrestled a deep ball from Stallworth, setting up Davenport's second score, from 4 yards. The Packers' 35-point first-half outburst was their biggest one-half output since Dec. 6, 1992, against Detroit.

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) — Prodded by Mike Tice's stern halftime speech, the Vikings came back from a 17-0 deficit to beat Green Bay 23-20. Paul Edinger kicked a career- and franchise-long 56-yard field goal as time ran out, lifting momentum-starved Minnesota past the Packers.

After losing their last two games by a combined 58-13 score and allegations of sexual misconduct by several players on a boat party emerging earlier in the month, the Vikings appeared headed for another ugly defeat after a flawless first half by Packers quarterback Brett Favre.

But Culpepper, who went 23 for 31 for 280 yards and two touchdowns with no interceptions, came to life — and Edinger came through with his third field goal of the game.

Ryan Longwell tied it at 20 with 24 seconds remaining on a 39-yard kick after missing two earlier field goals for the Packers. After the kick-off, Culpepper threw a 14-yard pass to Mewelde Moore and a 12-yard pass to Robinson — who stepped out and stopped the clock with 2 seconds left on the Green Bay 38. Favre was busy thinking about overtime when he turned to watch Edinger's winner. His teammates were just as shocked. And the Packers returned to Wisconsin in much worse shape. Carted off with severe injuries were receiver Robert Ferguson (knee, second quarter) and running back Ahman Green (quadricep tendon, fourth quarter).

"This is the hand we're dealt, and these are the cards we have to play with," said coach Mike Sherman, denying that this was a low point for his team. "If I looked on the field and saw guys who didn't try or quit, it'd be a low point. But our guys battled."

With more time to throw in the second half, Culpepper looked as comfortable as he has all season. He passed for 228 yards after halftime, finding Moore for a 14-yard touchdown with 3:10 left to give the Vikings a 20-17 edge.

Culpepper was constantly under pressure in the first half and Green Bay notched five sacks, two on third down that ended first-quarter drives. Green Bay took a 7-0 lead early in the second quarter when Donald Driver made a 22-yard catch in the corner of the end zone by cradling the ball against his right elbow. The Vikings then drove to the Packers 35, where Culpepper fumbled the snap on fourth-and-1.

Driver broke four tackles on a 40-yard catch and run that set up a 4-yard TD toss from Favre to Antonio Chatman late in the second quarter that made it 14-0. Koren Robinson returned the subsequent kickoff 72 yards, but Nick Barnett forced a Moore fumble on the next play and Kaber Gbaja-Biamila recovered.

CINCINNATI (AP) — Brett Favre threw five interceptions, something he'd never done in the regular season. He had a fan steal the ball from his hand during a last-minute drive, something he'd never seen before. Cincinnati held on for a 21-14 victory that left the Green Bay Packers quarterback lying motionless on the field, exhausted and overwhelmed by it all. This one was as tough as any during his 13-year career.

Facing the team that jump-started his career with a 1992 comeback blurred by time, Favre nearly overcame his five interceptions and an unexpected interruption that helped Cincinnati (6-2) hold on. Backed up on their 5-yard line with 56 seconds left, the Packers got a break with a 48-yard pass interference penalty. Cincinnati's orange-shirted defense tried to catch its breath while the sideline fretted.

"I was scared to death," said Carson Palmer, who put the Bengals ahead with three touchdown passes. "I said on the sideline, 'This is scary.' Then, when they got the ball again and they get that flag, I'm saying, 'We're going into OT.'"

The Packers (1-6) came up 28 yards short. Going without a huddle against a reeling defense, the Packers had a play blown dead from the 28 when a fan jumped out of the stands and ran onto the field. The man grabbed the ball out of Favre's hand and eluded security, which needed several minutes to tackle and arrest him.

"That did slow it down and give us a chance to huddle, and we kind of came together as a defense," linebacker Brian Simmons said. "But you don't want to see that because somebody could get hurt."

Favre was sacked on the next play, and was under heavy pressure as he threw his last pass from beyond the line of scrimmage, an illegal completion that came up short, anyway. Bengals coach Marvin Lewis acknowledged that the security delay changed the momentum.

The Bengals had five interceptions for the third time this season, the first team to do so since Kansas City in 1970.

Favre passed John Elway and moved into second place for career passes and yards, but couldn't overcome the mistakes that left the Packers in unfamiliar territory. They haven't had a losing record since 1991, when Favre was a backup in Atlanta.

Green Bay's Antonio Chatman set a career high with eight catches for 97 yards. ... Tony Fisher, forced to make his second career start because the Packers' top two running backs were hurt, carried 17 times for 51 yards and a touchdown. He also blocked two pass rushers on one play. ... Favre's sack on the second-to-last play ended a string of 150 Green Bay passes without a sack.
