MANITOWOC CO. MAN IS DEAD AT IRON MOUNTAIN

Edward Elmer, 39, former Manitowoc county man, died at his home at Iron Mountain, Florence county where he held office as district attorney, yesterday following an operation for ulcer of the stomach which he underwent.
