

MRS. W. ELMER DIES AT HOME

Cooperstown Resident To Be Buried On Saturday

Mrs. Barbara Elmer, widow of the late Wencil Elmer, and for years a resident of Cooperstown died Thursday night at her home in the village of Denmark where she resided since 1917. She was 83 years of age. Funeral services will be held Saturday at 9 a. m. from All Saints church at Denmark, with interment at Evergreen cemetery here.

The deceased was born in Bohemia, and came to this country with her parents at an early age, the family settling at Maribel. In 1868 she married Wencil Elmer and they lived first on a farm near Maribel and later located on a farm in Cooperstown for 40 years. The couple disposed of their farm in 1917 and moved to Denmark and Mr. Elmer passed away that same year.
