Louis T. (Tommy) Prucha, 75, retired longtime employe in the office of Plant No. 1, Mirro Aluminum Co., Two Rivers, died early Tuesday night at Hamilton Memorial Home, Two Rivers.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Deja & Martin Funeral Chapels and at 11 a.m. at Holy Redeemer Catholic Church, Two Rivers. The Rev. Paul Schumacher will officiate and burial will be in Holy Cross Cemetery, Two Rivers.

Mr. Purcha was born Nov. 17, 1898, at Two Rivers, son of the late Thomas and Mary Pelishek Prucha. He attended public graded schools and was graduated from Two Rivers High School with the Class of 1917. During his high school years he worked part time in the Mirro firm office and in 1918 he enlisted in the Army in World War I. He was discharged with the rank of sergeant in May of 1919.
