Mrs. Cecelia Schaden, 91, formerly of 1625 - 24th St., Two Rivers, who resided at Shady Lane Home, Manitowoc, the past two and one half years, died early Tuesday morning at Two Rivers Community Hospital.

Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Thursday at Deja and Martin Funeral Chapels and 10:30 a.m. at St. Luke Catholic Church, Two Rivers. The Rev. Robert Ryhner will officiate with burial in Holy Cross Cemetery, Two Rivers.
